Event Information

This document contains all relevant information for participants of “Rund um Dahlen” 2026 and is intended to ensure smooth participation in the event. Please observe the information and requirements in order to guarantee an efficient and safe running of the event.



1. Classes and Championships

The following classes will start:

- Within the Int. German Enduro Championship (DEM):
 - German Enduro Championship E1, E2 and E3
 - dmsj German Enduro Junior Championship J1 and J2
 - German Enduro Team Championship
- Within the German Enduro Cup (DEC):
 - German Enduro Cup classes E1 B, E2 B and E3 B
 - dmsj German Enduro Youth Cup
 - German Enduro Cup Team Championship
- Within the German Enduro Cup („Pokal“):
 - German Enduro Senior Cup
 - German Enduro Super Senior Cup
 - German Enduro Women’s Cup

The Supplementary Regulations and the event timetable are available via the [official notice board in RaceSystem](#).

2. Required Rider Licences

To participate in DEC classes, riders must hold at least one of the following licences:

- DMSB C Licence (annual licence)
- DMSB Race Card for the event only (valid for both days)

The C licence and the Race Card are non-scoring licences. Holders are eligible to start but do not receive championship points and are not entitled to a permanent start number. Only B licences, youth licences (J) or A licences are eligible for championship scoring.

DMSB licences are issued exclusively in digital form and are linked to a cross-season motorsport ID. Further information and detailed regulations can be found on the DMSB website.

Important:

For entries of riders holding licences from other federations, a start permission from the respective federation (“start authorisation abroad”) must be presented.

3. Entries

All entries must be submitted via www.racesystem.org.

Closing date for individual entries: 08 March 2026 (may be extended).

Closing date for team entries: 21 March 2026, 17:00.

The entry fee for all classes is €100. The rental fee for the transponder is already included.



Important:

Please make sure that all personal data, licence data and motorcycle data in your profile at www.racesystem.org are updated before administrative control.

4. Entry Confirmation

Entry confirmation will be sent by e-mail via the RaceSystem entry portal.

The payment status will be updated by the organiser at a later stage; therefore the information shown in RaceSystem may temporarily be outdated.

An [always up-to-date starting list](#) is available in RaceSystem.

5. Accommodation

Accommodation options are available via the [Municipality of Dahlen’s list of local hotels and guesthouses](#).

6. Start Numbers

The allocated start number will be displayed on www.racesystem.org once the entry has been confirmed. Start numbers are not provided by the organiser and must be obtained by the riders themselves.

7. Official Notice Board

All event information as well as short-notice announcements will be published digitally on the [official notice board at RaceSystem.org](#).

8. Regulation Updates 2026

The most important regulation changes for the season are [summarised on the DEM website](#). Please note: This information is only available in German. We recommend using a translation tool (such as DeepL or Google Translate) to review the details.

9. Travel

Dahlen can be reached conveniently by various means of transport.

By car:

Motorway A14, exits Mutzschen or Döbeln Nord.

Dedicated parking areas will be established near the special tests. These are shown on the [event information map](#) under “Spectator Points”.

By public transport:

S-Bahn and Regional Express connections to Dahlen station, approx. 1 km walking distance to the paddock.

10. Race Direction Office

The Race Direction Office (Event Headquarters) is located in the [Dahlen Carnival Club building, Bahnhofstraße 116e](#), Dahlen.

This is your primary point of contact for any questions regarding the event.

11. Administrative Checks

Administrative checks will take place in the [building of the Dahlen Carnival Club](#) (near the paddock). Administrative checks are carried out digitally; no documents for technical inspection will be issued.

The following documents must be presented:

- Rider licence (only for non-DMSB licences)
 - For riders with licences issued by other federations: start authorisation abroad
- Driving licence (original)
- Motorcycle registration certificate
- If using another rider’s motorcycle: written authorisation from the owner (may also be signed on site)

DMSB licences are verified digitally in advance and only need to be presented if the verification was unsuccessful.

Minor riders must attend accompanied by their legal guardians (or with written authorisation).

A smooth administrative check can only be ensured if all personal data, licence data and motorcycle data in the www.racesystem.org profile are fully up to date.

12. Transponders

New active transponders will be used. Personal transponders can no longer be used. The rental fee is already included in the entry fee.

Each participant receives a transponder during administrative checks which must be mounted on the motorcycle before technical inspection.

Further information on the use of the new transponders will be provided separately.

13. Technical Inspection

Technical inspection of the motorcycles takes place on the [market square in Dahlen](#). The [Technical Regulations of the DMSB Enduro Rulebook](#) apply.

Each participant is responsible for ensuring that the motorcycle complies with the road registration requirements of the country in which it is registered. The organiser is not legally authorised to verify compliance with these requirements.

Technical inspection checks only the safety of the motorcycle and compliance with the DMSB technical regulations. A valid road registration cannot be derived from the technical inspection. In the event of an incident on public roads, the rider alone is responsible before the authorities.



Important:

Authorities require the use of an **embossed sport licence plate** (not printed) with minimum dimensions of 13 cm × 10.5 cm in addition to indicators and mirrors. Checks have been announced.

14. Parc fermé

A Parc Fermé will be established from Saturday (after technical inspection) until Sunday (until the start of the last rider) on the [market square in Dahlen](#).

After technical inspection, access cards for the Parc Fermé will be issued. Motorcycles may only be collected upon return of this card.

After the start of the last rider, the Parc Fermé will be dissolved.

15. Start and Finish

Start and finish of the event are located on the [market square in Dahlen](#). The walking distance to the paddock is approximately 20 minutes.

Before crossing the finish line, riders must check in at the Time Control (TC) in the paddock. The official finish is located on the market square where the final technical inspection will take place.

16. Starting Order

The starting order is as follows:

1. Riders according to last year's Championship classification A (DEM classes)
2. Riders according to last year's Championship classification B (DEC classes)
3. Riders according to last year's Championship classification C

The exact starting times will be published on the day before the event.

17. Admission Tickets

An admission fee of € 10 applies for all special tests and main spectator areas. Admission is free up to the age of 15.

Each rider receives two admission wristbands for team members during administrative checks.

18. Livetiming

Live timing with continuously updated results is available via <http://www.racesystem.org/>.

19. Course / Transfers

The total length of one lap is approximately 70 km, with an off-road portion of roughly 75%. A general overview of the track can be found on the [information map](#).

Participants must complete the following number of laps:

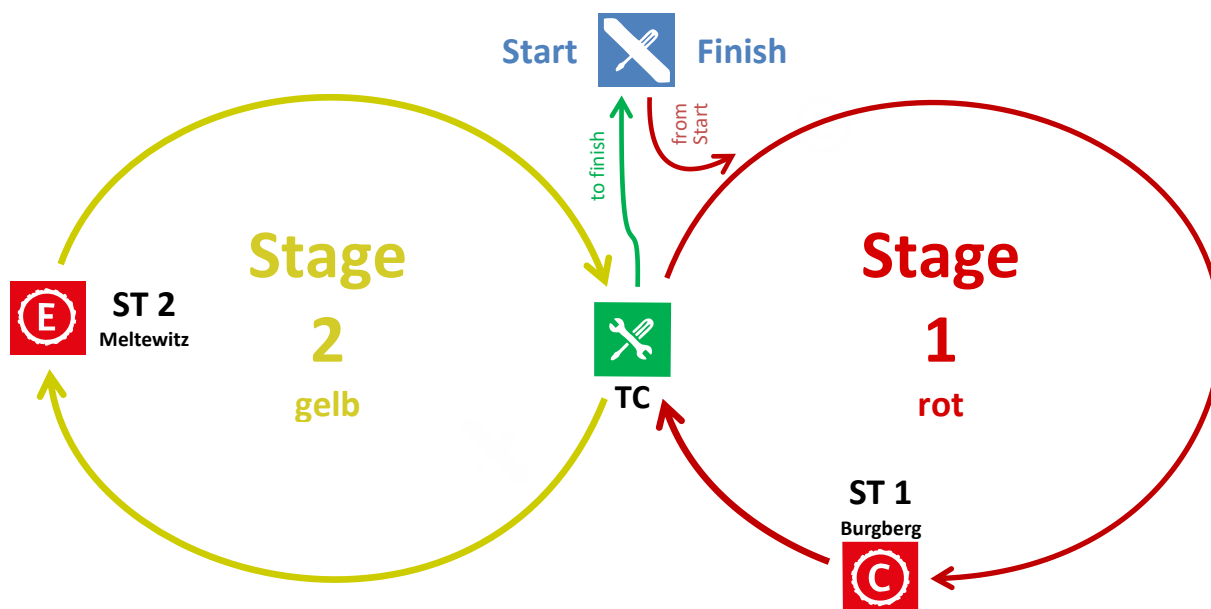

- DEM Classes (Nos. 1–299): 3 laps
- DEC Classes (Nos. 301–699): 3 laps
- Group C Classes (Nos. 701–999): 2 ½ laps

Each lap consists of two stages:

1. Red loop (east) with the Cross Test Burgberg
2. Yellow loop (west) with the Enduro Test Meltewitz

Important:

All riders and spectators must strictly observe the regulations of the German Road Traffic Act (StVO), especially speed limits!

20. Sonderprüfungen

Per lap, two special tests have to be completed

1. Crosstest Burgberg at the training ground of the MSC Dahlen e.V.
[Map link](#) A medium-length test with parts of the cross track as well as surrounding meadows and woods.
2. Endurotest Meltewitz at the training ground of SHC Meltewitz e.V.
[Map link](#) A medium-length enduro test with single trails.

The start and finish are next to each other in all tests.



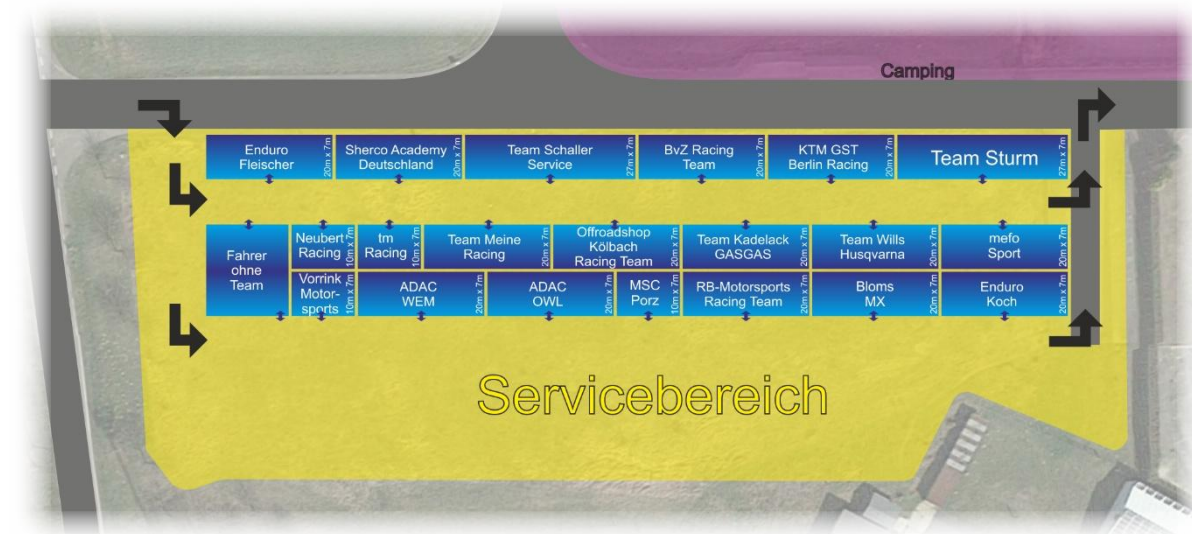
Important:

Inspection of the special tests is permitted from **Friday (20 March) from 08:00** according to the DMSB Enduro Regulations!

21. Service area / paddock

For both stages, the service area in the paddock ([Dahlen industrial park](#)) will be used. Refuelling is permitted only here and only with a fuel mat.

Water and electricity connections are not available in the service area.

Shopping facilities and petrol stations are located near the paddock.

The environmental regulations set forth by the DMSB (German Motor Sport Federation) must be strictly followed. In addition, you are required to take all of your waste home with you after the event.

Each team must keep at least one fire extinguisher immediately available in the service area.

22. Time Controls

During each stage, riders must adhere to the target times set by the organizer. The exact lap and time specifications will be announced the day before the event.

The time control (TC) is positioned directly after the service area in the paddock ([Dahlen industrial park](#)) at the end of each loop. A single time control will be used for both loops, eliminating the need to check for specific gates.

The completely pre-calculated target times of all TCs and all participants ("Timetable") will be published on the notice board of the event. A delay of more than 15 minutes from the scheduled arrival time at a time control results in disqualification for the DEM classes. For all other classes, disqualification occurs after a 20-minute delay.

23. Information for Followers

Sports license plates (13 cm x 10.5 cm) are only permitted for participating riders. Followers are only allowed to move in road traffic with the regular (large) license plate, turn signals and mirrors. Compliance with the German traffic rules must be observed.

24. Transponderrückgabe

Transponders must be returned at the finish on the market square in Dahlen during the final technical inspection. Participants retiring from the race early must return their transponders directly to the Race Direction Office.

25. Award Ceremony

The award ceremony will take place on the market square in Dahlen starting at approximately 16:30.
